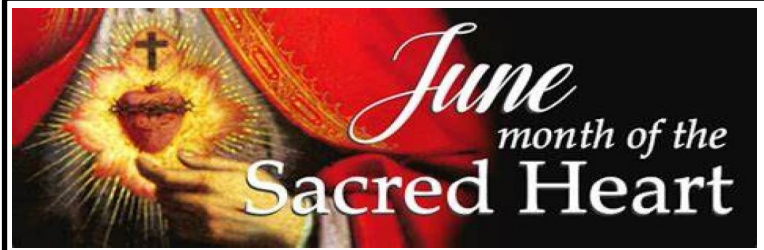

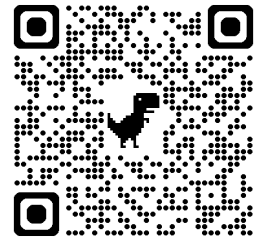

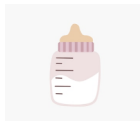

### Children's Liturgy

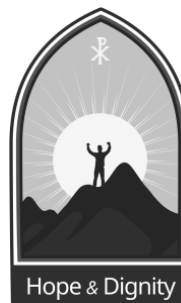
**Children's Liturgy will conclude on June 23**
