Feast of Corpus Christi, Sunday, June 2

The Corpus Christi Procession is a centuries-old tradition of the Catholic Faith, to process the Real Presence of Jesus, the Eucharist, in Public.

A St. Mary's Corpus Christi Procession will follow the 9am Mass on Sunday, June 2.

This will begin with the Exposition of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist, the Procession, and will finish with Benediction and Reposition. **This adds only 10 minutes to the Mass**

All Parishioners are welcome to join in this Procession.

Please pray the rosary.

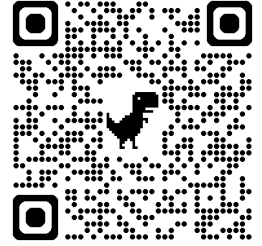

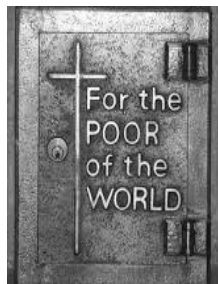
when hymns are to be sung during Mass?
